

Call for Papers: Second Announcement

The International Conference on Mesoscale Convective Systems (MCSs) and High-Impact Weather (ICMCS-VIII) will be held on 7-9 March 2011 at Nagoya University Noyori Conference Hall, Nagoya, Japan. It will be organized by the East Asia Weather Research Association and sponsored by Japan Meteorological Society and Nagoya University.

The main theme of this conference is "understanding development mechanisms of mesoscale convective systems and high-impact weather in East Asia and improving their forecast accuracy." Topics include but not limited to: 1) MCSs and the East Asian monsoon frontal system; 2) tropical cyclone genesis, structure, and forecasting; 3) orographically- induced precipitation systems; 4) synoptic/meso-/cloud scale processes associated with heavy rainfall/snowfall; 5) data assimilation and adaptive observations; 6) high- resolution numerical forecast of high impact weather/climate phenomena; 7) field campaigns; 8) observation equipments and 9) quantitative precipitation forecast/estimation (QPF/QPE).

Authors are encouraged to submit a 1-page abstract by **27 December 2010**. Extended abstracts are due by **7 February 2011**, with a maximum of 4 pages for accepted authors and 8 pages for invited speakers. Some selected papers may be published in a special issue of the Journal of the Meteorological Society of Japan (JMSJ).

Submission of abstracts and registration should be made on-line through the conference webpage.
